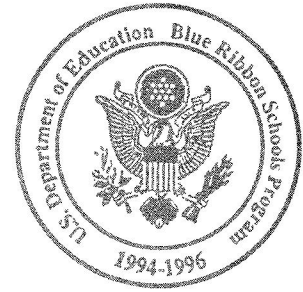

Letter of Understanding for Dual Enrollment AGS Students

Upper Dublin students participating in the dual enrollment component of the Advanced Geosciences 371 or 381 are concurrently enrolled as students at the West Chester University of Pennsylvania and are in every sense of the word, *college students*. As such, students are subject to all university provisions including deadlines for dropping classes (which can affect a refund of the tuition fee), the school's code of conduct and disciplinary procedures regarding academic dishonesty, etc. As part of the introductory portion of the course, UDHS students are required to read the sections of WCU's student handbook related to academic honesty and the code of conduct so they are familiar with its provisions.

Should a dual enrollment student not be able to meet all academic requirements of an AGS course approved as part of the UDHS-WCU agreement including assignments and cumulative exams, the option to receive WCU credit for the course may be denied based on an assessment by WCU designees. Should there be an instance of academic dishonesty, disciplinary issues, or other violations of the code of conduct that lead to disciplinary action, students are bound by the WCU disciplinary code for purposes of dual enrollment. In such cases, direct communication between the AGS instructor and WCU is required so officials there can advise the UDHS student of any ramifications to the student's standing as a dual-enrolled WCU student.

By signing this document, you attest to understanding the provisions contained in it and the nature of dual enrollment status in the Advanced Geosciences courses. It is also understood that participation in the dual enrollment portion of the courses is voluntary and plays no part in a UDHS student's academic standing or decision making process regarding UDHS internal disciplinary matters.
